NOTICE

(Admission to HS 2nd yr, UG/BCA 3rd & 5th Semesters, PG 3rd Semester and MCA 3rd & 5th Semesters)

This is for general information to all concerned that admission to regular HS 2nd yr, UG/BCA 3rd and 5th semesters, PG 3rd semester, and MCA 3rd and 5th semesters will be conducted ONLINE through the Cotton University website (<u>https://www.cottonuniversity.ac.in</u>) from **13 September 2019**, *except for those seeking admission under the Fee Waiver Scheme of Govt. of Assam.* The payment of fees will be accepted through debit/credit cards and online banking. **The last date of submission of fees for students without fee waiver is 17 September 2019**.

The fee structure for each course is available in the University website and students are requested to read the documents carefully.

Fee Waiver: The renewal admissions of students eligible for free admission shall be conducted on a date to be announced after declaration of UG & PG $2^{nd}/4^{th}$ Semester results (expected soon). The rules governing waiver of fees shall be as per Govt. O.M. No.AHE639/2018/11 dated 29/05/2019. The notification may be accessed online through the url

The following important points may be noted:

- (i) Students taking admission in any self-financing course are not eligible under this scheme.
- (ii) Students need to submit an income certificate from the Local Revenue Circle Officer which states that the parental income is less than Rs. 2.00 lakhs from all sources.
- (iii) Only those students seeking readmission in 3rd and 2nd year who had been admitted under the fee waiver scheme during 2017-18 and 2018-19 academic sessions shall be eligible to avail the scheme for the current year **provided they have requisite attendance and no back paper**.
- (iv) The students under the fee waiver scheme will have to pay three of the components of the total fees, namely, (a) Students' Welfare and Activity fee, (b) Students' Union fee, and (c) Magazine fee.
